Matthew 6:9-15

Our Father in the heavens . . .

- ⑤ Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us.

- ① Make us complete in every good work to do His will.
- ② Working in us what is well pleasing in His sight.

Colossians 4:12

Epaphras, who is one of you, a bondservant of Christ, greets you, **always laboring fervently for you in prayers, that you may stand perfect and complete in all the will of God.**

Colossians 1:9-11

→ I do not cease to pray for you . . .

- ① That we will be filled with the knowledge of His will.
- ② With all wisdom and spiritual understanding.
- ③ That we may walk worthy of the Lord.
- ④ That we fully please Him.
- ⑤ That we be fruitful in every good work.
- ⑥ That we will increase our knowledge of Him.
- ⑦ That He will strengthen us with all might, according to His glorious power.
- ⑧ For all endurance and longsuffering with joy.

1 Peter 5:10-11

→ May the God of all grace, who called us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after we have suffered a while . . .

- ① Perfect us.
- ② Establish us.
- ③ Strengthen us.
- ④ Settle us.

→ To Him be the glory and the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

Ephesians 1:17-19

→ I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory . . .

- ① May give us the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him.
- ② That He may open the eyes of our understanding . . .
- ③ That we may know what is the hope of His calling,
- ④ That we may know what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints,
- ⑤ That we may know what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power.

Ephesians 3:14-21

→ I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named . . .

- ① That God would grant us, according to the riches of His glory, strengthen us with might in the inner man.
- ② That Christ may dwell in our hearts through faith.
- ③ That we may be rooted and grounded in love . . .
- ④ That we may be able to comprehend (grasp) what is the width and length and depth and height - to know the love of Christ which passes knowledge.
- ⑤ That we may be filled with all the fullness of God.

→ Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

Philippians 1:9-11

→ I pray . . .

- ① That our love may abound still more and more . . .
- ② in knowledge and all discernment.
- ③ That we may approve the things that are excellent.
- ④ That we may be sincere and without offense till the day of Christ,
- ⑤ Being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by Jesus Christ.

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12

→ I always pray that . . .

- ① . . . God would count us worthy of His calling.
- ② . . . God would fulfill all the goodness and the work of faith with power.
- ③ . . . the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in us and us in Him.

→ According to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ.

Colossians 2:1-7

→ I want you to know how great a struggle I have on your behalf . . . that . . .

- ① . . . our hearts may be encouraged (strengthened),
- ② . . . we be **knitted** together in love,
- ③ . . . we attain to all the **riches** of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of the Father and of Christ, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
- ④ . . . we not be deceived by persuasive words,
- ⑤ . . . we be of good order (disciplined),
- ⑥ . . . we be steadfast in our faith,
- ⑦ . . . we walk as Christ walked, (being Christ to one another)
- ⑧ . . . God will root us, build us up, establish us, and school us,
- ⑨ . . . we overflow with thanksgiving in everything.
