Fear of the LORD

(2 Chronicles 19:7) Now therefore, let the fear of the LORD be upon you; take care and do *it*, for *there is* no iniquity with the LORD our God, no partiality, nor taking of bribes."

(2 Chronicles 19:9) And he commanded them, saying, "Thus you shall act in the fear of the LORD, faithfully and with a loyal heart:

(Job 28:28) And to man He said, 'Behold, the fear of the Lord, that *is* wisdom, And to depart from evil *is* understanding.' "

(Psalms 19:9) The fear of the LORD *is* clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the LORD *are* true *and* righteous altogether.

(Psalms 34:11) Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD.

(Psalms 111:10) The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom; A good understanding have all those who do *His commandments*. His praise endures forever.

(Proverbs 1:7) The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of knowledge, *But* fools despise wisdom and instruction.

(Proverbs 1:29) Because they hated knowledge And did not choose the fear of the LORD,

(Proverbs 2:5) Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge of God.

(Proverbs 8:13) The fear of the LORD *is* to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.

(Proverbs 9:10) The fear of the LORD *is* the beginning of wisdom, And the knowledge of the Holy One *is* understanding.

(Proverbs 10:27) The fear of the LORD prolongs days, But the years of the wicked will be shortened.

(Proverbs 14:26) In the fear of the LORD *there is* strong confidence, And His children will have a place of refuge.

(Proverbs 14:27) The fear of the LORD *is* a fountain of life, To turn *one* away from the snares of death.

(Proverbs 15:16) Better *is* a little with the fear of the LORD, Than great treasure with trouble.

(Proverbs 15:33) The fear of the LORD *is* the instruction of wisdom, And before honor *is* humility.

(Proverbs 16:6) In mercy and truth Atonement is provided for iniquity; And by the fear of the LORD *one* departs from evil.

(Proverbs 19:23) The fear of the LORD *leads* to life, And *he who has it* will abide in satisfaction; He will not be visited with evil.

(Proverbs 22:4) By humility and the fear of the LORD Are riches and honor and life.

(Proverbs 23:17) Do not let your heart envy sinners, But *be zealous* for the fear of the LORD all the day.

(Proverbs 28:14) Blessed is the one who fears the LORD always, but whoever hardens his heart will fall into calamity.

(Isaiah 11:2) The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and **of the fear of the LORD**.

(Isaiah 11:3) **His delight** *is* **in the fear of the LORD**, And He shall not judge by the sight of His eyes, Nor decide by the hearing of His ears;

(Isaiah 33:6) Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of your times, *And* the strength of salvation; **The fear of the LORD** *is* **His treasure**.

(Acts 9:31) Then the churches throughout all Judea, Galilee, and Samaria had peace and were edified. And **walking in the fear of the Lord** and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, they were multiplied.

Fear the LORD

(Deuteronomy 6:2) that you may fear the LORD your God, to keep all His statutes and His commandments which I command you, you and your son and your grandson, all the days of your life, and that your days may be prolonged.

(Deuteronomy 6:13) You shall fear the LORD your God and serve Him, and shall take oaths in His name.

(Deuteronomy 6:24) And the LORD commanded us to observe all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, for our good always, that He might preserve us alive, as *it is* this day.

(Deuteronomy 10:12) "And now, Israel, what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul,

(Deuteronomy 10:20) You shall fear the LORD your God; you shall serve Him, and to Him you shall hold fast, and take oaths in His name.

(Deuteronomy 14:23) And you shall eat before the LORD your God, in the place where He chooses to make His name abide, the tithe of your grain and your new wine and your oil, of the firstborn of your herds and your flocks, **that you may learn to fear the LORD your God always**.

(Deuteronomy 17:19) And it shall be with him, and he shall read it all the days of his life, that he may **learn to fear the LORD** his God and be careful to observe all the words of this law and these statutes,

(Deuteronomy 31:12) Gather the people together, men and women and little ones, and the stranger who *is* within your gates, that they may hear and **that they may learn to fear** the LORD your God and carefully observe all the words of this law,

(Deuteronomy 31:13) and *that* their children, who have not known it, may hear and **learn to fear the LORD** your God as long as you live in the land which you cross the Jordan to possess."

(Joshua 4:24) that all the peoples of the earth may know the hand of the LORD, that it is mighty, **that you may fear the LORD** your God forever."

(Joshua 24:14) "Now therefore, **fear the LORD**, serve Him in sincerity and in truth, and put away the gods which your fathers served on the other side of the River and in Egypt. Serve the LORD!

(1 Samuel 12:14) If you fear the LORD and serve Him and obey His voice, and do not rebel against the commandment of the LORD, then both you and the king who reigns over you will continue following the LORD your God.

(1 Samuel 12:24) **Only fear the LORD**, and serve Him in truth with all your heart; for consider what great things He has done for you.

(2 Kings 17:25) And it was so, at the beginning of their dwelling there, *that* they did not fear the LORD; therefore the LORD sent lions among them, which killed *some* of them.

(2 Kings 17:28) Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and **taught them how they should fear the LORD**.

(Psalms 15:4) In whose eyes a vile person is despised, **But he honors those who fear the LORD**; He *who* swears to his own hurt and does not change;

(Psalms 22:23) You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!

(Psalms 33:8) Let all the earth fear the LORD; Let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him.

(Psalms 34:9) Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints! *There is* no want to those who fear Him.

(Psalms 115:11) You who fear the LORD, trust in the LORD; He is their help and their shield.

(Psalms 115:13) He will bless those who fear the LORD, Both small and great.

(Psalms 118:4) Let those who fear the LORD now say, "His mercy endures forever."

(Psalms 135:20) Bless the LORD, O house of Levi! You who fear the LORD, bless the LORD!

(Proverbs 3:7) Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil.

(Proverbs 24:21) My son, fear the LORD and the king; Do not associate with those given to change;

(Jeremiah 26:19) Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah ever put him to death? **Did** he not fear the LORD and seek the LORD's favor? And the LORD—relented concerning the doom which He had pronounced against them. But we are doing great evil against ourselves."

(Hosea 3:5) Afterward the children of Israel shall return and seek the LORD their God and David their king. **They shall fear the LORD** and His goodness in the latter days.

(Hosea 10:3) For now they say, "We have no king, **Because we did not fear the LORD**. And as for a king, what would he do for us?"

(Jonah 1:9) So he said to them, "I *am* a Hebrew; and I fear the LORD, the God of heaven, who made the sea and the dry *land*."

(Malachi 3:16) Then those who feared the LORD spoke to one another, And the LORD listened and heard *them;* So a book of remembrance was written before Him For those who fear the LORD And who meditate on His name.

Fear God

(Genesis 22:12) And He said, "Do not lay your hand on the lad, or do anything to him; for now I know that you **fear God**, since you have not withheld your son, your only *son*, from Me."

(Exodus 18:21) Moreover you shall select from all the people able men, **such as fear God**, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place *such* over them *to be* rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens.

(Deuteronomy 25:18) how he met you on the way and attacked your rear ranks, all the stragglers at your rear, when you *were* tired and weary; **and he did not fear God**.

(Job 1:9) So Satan answered the LORD and said, "Does Job fear God for nothing?"

(Psalms 66:16) Come and hear, all you who fear God, And I will declare what He has done for my soul.

(Ecclesiastes 5:7) For in the multitude of dreams and many words *there is* also vanity. **But fear God**.

(Ecclesiastes 8:12) Though a sinner does evil a hundred *times*, and his *days* are prolonged, yet I surely know that it will be well with those who **fear God**, who fear before Him.

(Ecclesiastes 12:13) Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all.

(Luke 23:40) But the other, answering, rebuked him, saying, "Do you not even **fear God**, seeing you are under the same condemnation?

(Acts 13:16) Then Paul stood up, and motioning with *his* hand said, "Men of Israel, and you who **fear God**, listen:

(Acts 13:26) "Men *and* brethren, sons of the family of Abraham, and those among you who **fear God**, to you the word of this salvation has been sent.

(1 Peter 2:17) Honor all people. Love the brotherhood. Fear God. Honor the king.

Revelation 14:6-7 Then I saw another angel flying in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to those who dwell on the earth to every nation, tribe, tongue, and people— (7) saying with a loud voice, "Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water."

Fear Him

(Deuteronomy 8:6) "Therefore you shall keep the commandments of the LORD your God, to walk in His ways **and to fear Him.**

(Deuteronomy 13:4) You shall walk after the LORD your God **and fear Him**, and keep His commandments and obey His voice; you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him.

(Psalms 22:23) You who fear the LORD, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!

(Psalms 22:25) My praise *shall be* of You in the great assembly; I will pay My vows before **those who fear Him**.

(Psalms 25:14) The secret of the LORD *is* with those who fear Him, And He will show them His covenant.

(Psalms 33:18) Behold, the eye of the LORD *is* **on those who fear Him,** On those who hope in His mercy,

(Psalms 34:7) The angel of the LORD encamps all around **those who fear Him**, And delivers them.

(Psalms 34:9) Oh, fear the LORD, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him.

(Psalms 85:9) Surely His salvation *is* near to those who fear Him, That glory may dwell in our land.

(Psalms 103:11) For as the heavens are high above the earth, So great is His mercy toward those who fear Him;

(Psalms 103:13) As a father pities *his* children, **So the LORD pities those who fear** Him.

(Psalms 103:17) But the mercy of the LORD *is* from everlasting to everlasting On those who fear Him, And His righteousness to children's children.

(Psalms 111:5) He has given food to those who fear Him; He will ever be mindful of His covenant.

(Psalms 145:19) He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them.

(Psalms 147:11) The LORD takes pleasure in those who fear Him, In those who hope in His mercy.

(Matthew 10:28) And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.

(Luke 1:50) And His mercy is on those who fear Him From generation to generation.

(Luke 12:5) But I will show you whom you should fear: **Fear Him** who, after He has killed, has power to cast into hell; yes, I say to you, fear Him!

(Revelation 19:5) Then a voice came from the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all you His servants and those who **fear Him**, both small and great!"

Fear

(Philippians 2:12-13) Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; (13) for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure.

Psalms 2:11-12 Serve the LORD with fear, And rejoice with trembling. (12) Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish *in* the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed *are* all those who put their trust in Him.

Psalms 119:120 **My flesh trembles for fear of You**, And I am afraid of Your judgments.

Isaiah 66:2 For all those *things* My hand has made, And all those *things* exist," Says the LORD. "But on this *one* will I look: On *him who is* poor and of a contrite spirit, **And** who trembles at My word.

Psalms 89:7 God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, And to be held in reverence by all *those* around Him.

Psalms 76:11 Make vows to the LORD your God, and pay *them;* Let all who are around Him bring presents to Him **who ought to be feared.**

Jeremiah 10:7 Who would not fear You, O King of the nations? For this is Your rightful due. For among all the wise *men* of the nations, And in all their kingdoms, *There is* none like You.

Hebrews 12:28-29 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. (29) For our God *is* a consuming fire.

Revelation 15:3-4 They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: "Great and marvelous *are* Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true *are* Your ways, O King of the saints! (4) **Who shall not fear You, O Lord**, and glorify Your name? For *You* alone *are* holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."
