A Serious Letter

- Warning against an ENEMY WITHIN!
 - ➤ WOLVES IN SHEEP CLOTHING. (Matthew 7:15; Acts 20:29)

The Author(s) (Jude 1)

- GOD (2 Timothy 3:16-17)
 - ➤ Do we TREMBLE at His Word? (Isaiah 66:2, 5 Hebrews 4:13)
- Jude, brother of James, half-brother of Jesus Bond servant of Christ

The Readers (Jude 1)

- CALLED, SANCTIFIED, PRESERVED
- THOSE BEING SANCTIFIED. (Hebrews 10:14)

Has Our Greetings Changed? (Jude 2)

• Mercy, Peace, Love be multiplied to you!

Jude's Intent vs the Will of God

- Eternal purpose and providence of God.
- God always is working out His plan. (Proverbs 19:21; 16:9; Isaiah 46:10)

Our Common Salvation

- The Golden Chain of Grace (Romans 8:28-30)
- The grace of Elohiym, our Creator who <u>before</u> time chose us (Eph 1:4; Acts 13:48; Titus 1:2; Rom 8:29); predestined us (Eph 1:5, 11); graced us (2 Tim 1:9; Rom 8:29-30); and wrote His special people's names in the Book of Life of the Lamb (1 Peter 1:20; Rev 13:8; Luke 10:20)

- The grace of Adonai, our Lord, Ruler, Owner, Master, who <u>sovereignly willed</u> to have mercy and compassion on us and willed not to harden us! (Romans 9:15-18)
- The grace of Immanuel, God with us, who made Himself <u>no reputation</u> and became a <u>slave</u> obedient on to death to live and die for those whom the Father gave Him. (Philippians 2:5-9; Titus 2:14; John 6:37, 39; 17:2, 6, 8-9, 11, 24)
- The grace of Yahweh Makkeh, (the LORD who strikes) who sacrificed His own Son on our behalf. (Isa 53:10; Ezek 7:9; Zech 13:7)
- The grace of God, the Judge of all the Earth (Gen 18:25), who justified us based on nothing in ourselves but solely on what Christ, His Son, did on our behalf. (Romans 3:24-26:1; 8:1; 9:11, 16; 11:6; Eph 2:4-8; 2 Tim 1:9; Titus 3:3-5)
- The grace of God, the Holy Spirit who gave us the promised gift of eternal life. (Titus 1:2, 3:5; John 3:3-8)

Something MORE NECESSARY

- "necessary" ἀνάγκη anagke {an-ang-kay'} means "necessity imposed either by circumstances and/or by law of duty regarding to one's advantage".
- Circumstances: God's Word was/is being corrupted from within the Church! We will show this is true today and that many are being deceived into believing a false gospel in our next sermon. (Matthew 24:4-5, 11, 24)
- Duty: As a child of God, our Father's honor is our number one priority (Matt 6:9; Lev 10:3). We live so that He is honored and glorified. (Matt 5:16; Rom 15:6) As stewards of God's Word we are under <u>obligation</u> to earnestly contend for it.
- "to exhort" this is an exhortation from God. Ignore this exhortation and we ignore GOD!
- "to earnestly contend" is $\epsilon \pi \alpha \gamma \omega \nu i \zeta o \mu \alpha \iota$ {ep-ag-o-nid'-zom-ahee} means "to strive"; "to fight"; "to labor fervently" "to endeavor with strenuous zeal"; "to agonize"; "to make every effort".
 - The Holy Spirit uses the prefix epi to "supersize" the verb!
- Jude was/is calling <u>all</u> saints to STAND (and even die if necessary) for "<u>the faith</u>". (Jeremiah 9:3; 7:28; Isaiah 59:14-15; Hosea 4:1)
- This "the faith" was "once for all" delivered. The same "the faith" that was handed down to the saints of the first century is the exact same faith handed down to US! This "the faith" is what we must earnestly contend!
 - ➤ Man has no RIGHT to change it but he does!
- (Mark 7:1-13) People today will follow traditions and teachings of men that have been handed down rather than the **commandments** of God.
- "the faith" There is only ONE faith! (Ephesians 4:5; Galatians 1:6-9)
- "the faith" This is OBJECTIVE FAITH not SUBJECTIVE FAITH.
 - ➤ DOCTRINE comes from God. (John 7:16-17) See 2 John 9

- ➤ DOCTRINE comes from what is <u>written</u> and not from the opinions and teachings of men. (Ephesians 4:14)
- ➤ DOCTRINE is either TRUE or FALSE. (1 Timothy 1:3; 4:6-16)
- ➤ This is DOCTRINE. We are living in vv. 3-4 of 2 Timothy 4:1-4.
- ➤ Teachers/preachers are to <u>LABOR</u> in "word and doctrine". (1 Timothy 5:17; 2 Timothy 2:15)
- ➤ There is stricter judgment on those who teach/preach. (James 3:1)
- ➤ Any doctrine must lead to godliness/holiness/obedience. (1 Timothy 6:3)

Ancient Words - "the faith" (Jude 3)

- There is ONLY ONE FAITH. (Ephesians 4:4-6)
- There is ONLY ONE TRUE GOSPEL (Gen-Rev). (Galatians 1:6-9)
- Are we being changed by God's ancient words or are we changing the ancient words to say what we want them to say?
- Are we choosing God's ancient ways or are we determined to live according to 21st Century words because they are more comfortable? (Jeremiah 6:16-17)
 - ✗ Today, a great majority of the church believes truth to be what they think truth is.
 - X Today, a great majority of the church believes sin to be what they believe sin to be.
 - ✗ Today, a great majority of the church ignores the words written and therefore live their lives according to their opinions.
 - ✗ Today, a great majority of the church does not believe 1 Peter 4:12-17 or 2 Thessalonians 1:7-9 or Matthew 7:21-23.
 - ✗ Today, a great majority of the church is ignorant of the times we are living in and what must be done. (1 Chron 12:32; Matt 16:3; Luke 12:56-57)
- These <u>ancient</u> words ("the faith") have been handed down to <u>us</u> and we must now "earnestly contend" for them. (Jude 3)
- GOD's Word is TRUTH not what we think truth is! (John 17:17; Psalm 119:160)
- (Luke 4:4) "Man does not live on bread alone but on every word of God." a
 direct quote of the One we call LORD.
 - → Either we live our lives by the righteousness defined by God's Word <u>OR</u> we establish our own righteousness. (Romans 10:1-3; 1 John 3:10)

Obstacles to Obeying the Exhortation to Contend

- ① We do not believe that there is a battle to contend with. Not to "earnestly contend" is to not obey this exhortation. Not to obey this exhortation is not to obey GOD!
 - → We do not take God's warnings seriously. There is **no** sense of urgency.
- ② We do not believe that it is **OUR** responsibility. We believe that there is a battle but others will have to fight because we are too busy living our lives.
- 3 We are ignorant of the faith. My faith is based on what I believe not what

- the faith says! We establish our own righteousness! (Romans 10:3)
- ➤ We do not study and meditate on God's Word. (Psalm 1:1-3)
- ➤ We are comfortable in our ignorance!
- We have no genuine desire to "please" our Commanding Officer GOD. (2 Tim 2:3-4; Colossians 1:10; 1 Thess 4:1; Heb 11:5; 1 John 3:22)
- (5) We do not wear the **whole armor** of God believing that I can handle any temptation or deception that comes my way. (Eph 6:10-18)
- ® We are comfortable in <u>our relativism</u>. We do not believe that we must be of one mouth, one mind, one understanding, and one purpose. (1 Corinthians 1:10; Romans 15:5-6)
- We are ignorant of the enemy's tactics. (2 Corinthians 2:11; 4:2; 11:3, 13-15; Matthew 7:15; 13:33; 16:6, 11-12; 1 Corinthians 5:6-8; Galatians 5:9; 1 Peter 5:8; Acts 20:30; Romans 16:18; Galatians 1:7; Ephesian 4:14; Colossians 2:4, 8; 1 Timothy 4:1; 2 Timothy 3:1-5; 4:1-4; 3:13; 2 Peter 2:1-3; 1 John 2:18; 4:1; Revelation 2:2, 20) This is the theme of our next sermon in Jude.

It is Our ("the saints") Turn NOW

- → Examples from history
 - Martin Luther stood up against the powerful Catholic Church.
 - Martyrs joyfully gave their lives standing for the TRUTH like Jan Hus 1372-1415 42-43 years old.
 - Queen Mary in 1555 -1557 burned hundreds of Protestants at the stake.
 - William Tyndale (ca. 1494-1536 age 43) gave us our English Bible strangled and burned at the stake.
- → 2024 may be/is our turn! Will we "earnestly contend for <u>the</u> faith"? Even to the point of imprisonment or death?

Contending for the Faith

- We must remember that this letter <u>is</u> written to all saints and all saints have the <u>duty</u>, <u>obligation</u>, and <u>responsibility</u> to "earnestly contend". In order to obey this exhortation we must <u>know doctrine</u> and know it thoroughly. Therefore, Bible study is not an option.
- We are to demolish, destroy, cast down, over throw <u>any</u> theory, <u>any</u> human reasoning, <u>any</u> argument, <u>any</u> thought, <u>any</u> speculation, <u>any</u> opinion that does not line itself up <u>exactly</u> with Word of God. (2 Corinthians 10:4-6)
- We must not only stand for TRUTH but we must be "valiant for the TRUTH."
 - ★ One only STANDS for what is PRECIOUS to them.
 - ★ One only STANDS for what they DEEPLY believe.
 - ★ One only STANDS for what they REALLY love.
- Others will suffer if we do not earnestly contend for the faith.
- We must earnestly contend because the souls of our children and their children are at stake! (Consider Psalm 78:4-8)
