Doers of God's Written Word

Be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. (James 1:22; Matthew 7:21-23; 12:50; 1 John 2:3-4)

- Did you earnestly heed and do what you heard in last week's sermon? Or are you deceiving yourself that you are a Christian? (Hebrews 2:1; Luke 11:28; Matthew 7:24-29; 12:50; James 1:22; Hebrews 13:17)
- 2. Did you meditate on the meditation for this week (Psalm 119:1-2) or did you just ignore it and not look at it? Did you memorize Psalm 119:10? Are you seeking God with your whole heart and crying out to Him for help not to wander from His commandments?! Or did you believe that you do not need to cry out to God for His help in obeying His commandments?
- 3. Examine yourself by asking yourself the following questions from what you heard (or should have heard) in last week's sermon:
 - Do you take the warnings in Jude seriously?
 - Do you believe that you will stand before Christ and give an account of your works/stewardship/obedience? (2 Cor 5:9-10)
 - Do you believe that God will judge you according to His truth and not your opinion? (Psalm 96:10, 13)
 - Do you meditate on God's Law day and night? (Psalm 1:1-3)
 - Did you "watch and pray" this week so that you would not fall in temptation?
 - Do you believe that you might fall? Read carefully 1 Corinthians 10:12 and meditate on Psalm 119:10 again!
