Meditating on Psalm 23

DISCIPI ES MEDITATE

Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night.

(Psalms 1:1-2)

Rewards for Meditation

- (v. 1) The LORD is my shepherd.
- (v. 1) "I shall not want"
- (v. 5) "My cup runs over . . ."
- (v. 6) Promise
 - Continual divine goodness and mercy and assurance of eternal fellowship with the LORD!
- (v. 6) Surely, Goodness and Mercy Shall Follow Me
 - "Surely" the disciple is absolutely SURE of God's GRACE.
 - (v. 6) "Goodness" 512 times in the Old Testament.
 - ➤ What is the meaning of "goodness"?
 - → The quality of being morally good or virtuous.

- → From "good" that which is morally right; righteousness.
- ➤ BUT what is "goodness" here!
 - → Since this is the word of God man's definition is NOT sufficient!
 - Consider "good" in Genesis 1:31 "God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good."
 - Consider Isaiah 46:9-11; 45:7; Acts 15:18; 1 Peter 1:19-20
 - See Isaiah 53:10
 - See Matthew 19:17; Romans 3:12
 - See Matthew 11:20-26
 - → "Goodness" must be defined by God NOT man!
 - Consider Psalm 31:19; Lamentations 3:23-25
 - Consider 1 Corinthians 2:9
 - ★ God's goodness is GREAT greater than what any man can imagine.
 - ★ (Psalm 136:1-3) Oh! Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good!; for His mercy endures forever!

• (v. 6) "Mercy" or "Lovingkindness"

- → This Hebrew word found 241 times. It is translated: "mercy", "kindness"; lovingkindness.
 - "lovingkindness" Psalm 36:7-10; 40:11; 51:1; 63:3.
 - ★ (Psalm 136:1-3) "His lovingkindness is everlasting" (NASB); "His steadfast love endures forever" (ESV); "His loyal love" (NET); "His mercy endures forever" (NKJV); "His love is eternal" (CSB)
 - "mercy" Psalm 86:13-15; 57:13; 94:18; 103:8, 11, 17; 115:1-3; 119:64.
 - ★ (Lamentation 3:22-24) Consider the context of these verses.
 - "kindness" Psalm 31:21; 117:2; 119:76.

• (v. 6) "Shall follow me"

- "follow" "to run after; to chase; to put to flight; to hunt; to pursue"
 - 1. The verb is in the PERFECT mood show an action started and continuing to completion. As we saw in Lamentations 3:22-24.
 - 2. The verb picture one's determination not to give up or quit.

- (v. 6) "All the days of my life" ALL is ALL to the end!
- (v. 6) "And I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever."
 - ➤ The promise of promises to dwell with the LORD forever.
 - See Hebrews 11:13-16; Psalm 16:11; 17:15; 73:24-26; 2 Cor 5:1; Philippians 1:23.
