Feasts of the LORD (Leviticus 23)

- See Handout "The Feast of the Lord 2025"
- God gave His people *His* feasts after *He* redeemed them from Egypt.
- God gave His people **His** feasts to His people in order to share **His** joy with His people.
- One cannot share in God's joy unless he/she is a child of God.
- One cannot share in God's joy unless he/she is born-again. (John 3:3, 5)
- · God's joy is centered on His Son, Jesus Christ.
- All of *His* feasts point to and speak about His Son.
- God was/is the host. The people are only guests.
- All arrangements, the time, the place, the ordering of the feasts were under taken by GOD.
- NOTHING was left to the people. There was NO vote!
- True happiness comes from enjoying God, not what we believe is better!
- Three times a year God demanded/commanded that all male gather together with Him in Jerusalem to celebrate HIS feasts. (Exodus 23:14-17; 34:23-24; Deuteronomy 16:15-16) MEDITATE: Luke 14:12-24)

Feast of Weeks – Pentecost (Leviticus 23:15-22; Ephesians 3:1-13)

- Two loaves of bread with yeast/leaven! (1 Cor. 12:13; Rom. 11:17; Col 3:10-11)
- Jews and Gentiles supernaturally brought together to make one Church. And yet, God recognizes that there is no difference in their sin. (Eph 2:11-3:13)
 - ➤ (Ephesians 3:6) THE MYSTERY: JEWS and GENTILES ONE! THERE IS NO DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JEWISH and GENTILE SINNERS! THERE IS NO DIFFERENCE BETWEEN JEWISH and GENTILE BELIEVERS.
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW "in Christ" ONE BODY.
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW "fellow citizens" in the Kingdom of God.
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW "partakers of His promise in Christ."
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW "called to ONE hope."
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW God's "special people."
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW members of God's family.
 - ★ Jewish and Gentile believers are NOW "fellow heirs"

- ★ Jewish and Gentile believers NOW are partakers of the "unsearchable riches of Christ."
- ★ Jewish and Gentile believers NOW have EQUAL rights, privileges <u>and</u> responsibilities. They are **THE CHURCH of GOD!**
- A **new** grain offering. (Leviticus 23:16)
 - We, the Church, are a NEW CREATION. (2 Corinthians 5:17)
 - We, the Church, are RE-CREATED by God for GOD for WORKS. (Eph 2:10)
- It was a *firstfruit* offering. It was closely connected to the *firstfruit* of the Feast of Firstfruits. (1 Corinthians 15:20-23; Hebrews 2:11; Romans 8:23; 11:16)
- The New Testament Church was born at Pentecost!
 - By an act of God.
 - Man cannot mar or mutilate it.
 - The gates of Hades shall never prevail.(Matthew 16:18)
- This offering COULD NOT be offered to God BY ITSELF it had to be offered
 with the other offerings. The Church is ONLY acceptable (sweet) to God by
 the works of Christ. (Leviticus 23:18-19; 2:12; Ephesians 5:2)
- At the request of His beloved Son, God "shared" His own Spirit with His people His Church. (John 14:16-18) This is what we celebrate today!!

God Sent His Spirit to His Church!

- Pentecost is JUST AS important as the crucifixion, resurrection and ascension.
- The Church belongs to God! He purchased it with His blood. (Acts 20:28)
- God is SERIOUS about His Church.
- God's Word defines what Church is!
- Christianity is NOT personal. It is CORPORATE.
- One cannot say, "Christ is number one in my life (Luke 14:26-33)" without His Body being number one in your life. (Ephesians 1:22-23; 5:30)
- Christ laid down His life for THE CHURCH. (Ephesians 5:2, 25; Matt 20:28)
- Christ sent His Spirit to the THE CHURCH. (Acts 2:1-13)
- The Church is the BODY of Christ. A body has ONE HEAD. A body has many members BUT they are ONE BODY. (Rom 12:4-5; 1 Cori12:12-27)
- By definition, a body does everything together! (Romans 12:4-5)
- Each and every member is given grace/gifts for the profit and growth of the entire body. It takes every member <u>serving</u> the body for the body to grow.
 (Ephesians 4:1-16; 1 Corinthians 12:1-11; Romans 12:4-6; 1 Peter 4:10-11)

The Work of the Spirit - a gift of God (Galatians 4:6)

- 1. Conviction of sin. (John 16:7-11; Hebrews 4:12)
- 2. Regeneration. (John 3:1-8; 6:63; Ephesians 2:1, 5-6; Ezekiel 37:9)
 - ➤ To *raise* her from the dead!
 - The Spirit, and the Spirit alone, gives life. (John 6:63; 2 Cor. 3:6; Galatians 6:8; John 3:5; Eph 2:1-9; Ezekiel 37:1-14)

- 3. Access to the Father Ephesians 2:18
- 4. Unites us (each believer) to/in Christ. (1 Cor 12:13; John 17:11, 21-22; Col 3:3)
- 5. Equips us to do the work that God prepared beforehand for us to do. (Eph 2:10)
 - → 1 Corinthians 12:11; 1 Corinthians 12:7; Galatians 5:22-23
- 6. Seal us and become our <u>guarantee</u> of our inheritance. (Ephesians 1:13-14; 4:30; 2 Corinthians 1:22; 5:5; 2 Timothy 2:19)
- 7. Empower us. (Acts 1:8)
 - To witness of Christ and His work (Ephesians 2:10).
 - → Through what we say and do.
 - To fight the battle of sin.
 - → The *filling* of the Holy Spirit allows us to do this. (Eph 5:18; 6:10-20; Gal 5:16-25; 1 Cor 9:6; 1 Tim 6:12; 2 Tim 4:7)
 - To enable her to **serve** God. (1 Thess 1:9; Rom 7:6; 12:1, 11; 14:18; 16:18: Col 3:23-24: Hebrews 12:28: Matt 20:27-28)
- 8. Gifts us (uniquely) for use in a local body of believers. (Eph 4:1-16; 1 Cor 12:1-7)
- 9. Guide us into all truth and with the truth.
 - → (Romans 8:14) "For as many are <u>led</u> by the Spirit, these are the sons of God." (Romans 8:5, 9; Galatians 5:18; John 16:13; consider Acts 16:6-7)
- 10. Help and Strengthen us. (Eph. 3:16; 6:10; Isaiah 40:29-31; 41:10; Col 1:11
- 11. Teach us. (John 14:26; Luke 12:12)
- 12. Intercede for us. (Romans 8:26)
- 13. Comfort us. (John 14:16, 18, 26; 16:7)
- 14. Unite us (the Church). (Ephesians 4:1-7)
- 15. Flow OUT of us to minister to others. (John 7:37-38; Galatians 5:22-23)

What Did the Church Do When She Was Born? (Acts 2:42-47)

- She, the Body, *continued steadfastly* in studying doctrine together.
- She, the Body, *continued steadfastly* in Christian fellowship together..
- She, the Body, *continued steadfastly* in breaking bread together.
- She, the Body, *continued steadfastly* in praying together.
- She, the Body was *in one accord* in meeting together.

Command: Be Filled with the Holy Spirit (Ephesians 5:18)

What Is It "to be filled with Holy Spirit"?

- BE CONTROLLED by the Spirit
 - "do not be drunk with wine" ALCOHOL affects our MINDS.
 - → The State has determined that one beer/one glass of wine affects the way one can control an automobile. See Proverbs 31:4-5
 - → WARNING labels on medicines warn that people are not to drive or operate heavy machinery when taking it.

- ★ ALL this because SCIENCE has determined that these people are not in full control of themselves!
- **BUT** the Holy Spirit moved Paul to give us yet another command:
 - → "be filled with the Spirit"
 - ★ To be "filled" with the Spirit is to be completely under the control of the Spirit and not self.

What "Filling of the Spirit" is NOT

- It is not an experience.
- It is not a second blessing from God that makes us super-spiritual Christians.
- It is not the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
 - ★ ALL Christians receive the baptism of the Holy Spirit at conversion. (1 Corinthians 12:13)
- It is not the indwelling of the Holy Spirit. (1 Cor 6:19; 2 Cor 6:16)
- It is not a process of progressing in degrees of power.
- It is not the same thing as being sealed with the Holy Spirit. (Eph 1:13)
- It is not something that comes to us by only prayer.
- God NEVER commands us to be indwelt; baptized with; sealed with; or seek the baptism of the Holy Spirit.
- He has given us one and only one command: BE FILLED.

How to Obey this Command

- BUT the command is in the PASSIVE VOICE!!!! (Present tense; plural)
- We cannot control the Spirit like we cannot control the wind.
- ★ BUT . . . WE CAN RAISE THE SAILS
- ① Examine, Confess, Repent. (2 Cor 3:15; 1 John 1:9; Luke 13:1-5)
 - → Putting to death (mortifying) sin. (Col 3:5, 8; Rom 8:12-13; Gal 5:24)
- ② DEATH to SELF. (Luke 9:23)
 - → Be a SLAVE to God and OTHERS. (Philip 2:5-8; Matt 20:28; Romans 6:22)
- ③ Complete SURRENDER of will, intellect, body, time, talents, possessions, and desires to God. (Luke 14:33)
- PRAY! (Luke 11:13 in contrast to James 4:3) God gives perfect gifts.
- (Eph 5:19-20; Col 3:16; John 8:31)
 - ☆ As we fill ourselves with the written Word of God it controls our thinking and actions. (Psalm 1:1-3)
 - ☆ God's thoughts become our thoughts.
 - ☆ God's standard (holiness) becomes our standard.
 - ☆ God's work becomes our work. (John 5:19)
 - ☆ God's will becomes our will.
- ★ Being filled with the Holy Spirit is "walking thought by thought, decision by decision, act by act, word by word under the control of the Holy Spirit."
