 To IGNORE, DISOBEY, BE IGNORANT OF Peter's teachings and commands is to reject Christ and to reject Christ is to God Himself. (Luke 10:16)



- ★ A letter written PILGRIMS.
- Christians are STRANGERS and PILGRIMS in this world!
 - → STRANGERS: Our citizenship is NOT here, but heaven. (Philippians 3:20-21) Christians <u>are</u> to look, sound, and be strange to the people of the world. (1 John 3:1; John 15:18-19, 21; 16:1-3; 1 Peter 4:3-4)
 - → PILGRIMS: Christians are only "passing through" on a journey to a better place heaven. (Hebrews 11:13-16)
 - ★ (Psalm 43:3; 25:4-5; 119:105) Christians use the Word of God as their map and light to navigate their way. (Luke 4:4)
 - ★ Christians do not conform themselves to the world. (Romans 12:1-2; 1 John 2:15-17; James 4:4)
 - ★ We are to pass through this wilderness in fear. (1 Peter 1:17; 2:17; 3:15) If we fear God, we will not fear anything else.
 - → Disciples are in ENEMY territory. Our enemies are ALL around us -
 - ★ Our own lusts and desires! (1 Peter 2:11)
 - ➤ The Spirit and our flesh are constantly at battle with each other. (Romans 7:14-23; Gal5:16-22; 1 John 2:15-17)
 - THEREFORE, we cleanse OURSELVES (1 Cor 7:1), we daily (if not hourly) PRAY that God will continually FILL US with His Spirit. (Ephesians 5:18)
 - ★ The Devil, that roams the earth looking for saints to devour! (1 Peter 5:8: Matthew 4:1-11: Rev 12:9: 2 Cor 2:11: 11:14)
 - THEREFORE, disciples walk CIRCUMSPECTLY in the world. (Ephesians 5:15-17)
 - ★ The WORLD that is under the influence of the Devil. (1 John 5:19; James 4:4; 1 John 2:15-17)



- THEREFORE, disciples diligently GUARD their hearts (minds, emotions, and wills). (Proverbs 4:23) Disciples GUIDE their heart no the other way around. (Proverbs 3:5-6; Proverbs 23:19: 28:26: Jeremiah 17:9)
- → Blessed is the man whose heart is set on pilgrimage. (Psalm 84:5)
- → Pilgrims are constantly in battle with fleshly lusts that war against their souls. (1 Peter 2:11)
 - ➤ The disciple's WALK is a DIFFICULT one. BUT the difficult way leads to life. (Matthew 7:13-14)
- → Disciples live by promises rather than circumstances. (Hebrews 11:13-16)
- ★ A letter written to the ELECT of God (1 Peter 2:9; Ephesians 1:3-4; 2 Thess 2:13; Romans 8:28-30; Acts 13:48; 2 Timothy 1:9). THIS IS A GREAT HOPE OF A DISCIPLES! In the midst of troubles, tribulations, and persecutions the disciple KNOWS that he is one of God's special people. (Romans 8:28-39)



- ★ A letter written to SUFFERING SAINTS. (John 15:18-20; Acts 14:22; Philippians 1:29; 2 Timothy 3:12)
- ★ A letter to warn of GREATER persecution to come. (1 Peter 4:12)
- ★ A letter to those who have been SCATTERED.
- ★ A letter to US! (Romans 15:4)

13 Principles to Live by in a Hostile World (1 Peter 3:8-17)

Christ Suffered (UNJUSTLY) to Bring Us to God (1 Peter 3:18)

• We are saved only by the LIFE and DEATH of Christ. (Romans 5:9-10)

Arm Yourself (1 Peter 4:1-6)

- ★ Peter, again, points to disciple's RESPONSIBILITY!
 - ➤ We are WORK OUT our salvation. Consider Philippians 2:12-13.
- "since Christ suffered <u>for us"</u> points again back to 1 Peter 3:18.
- KNOWING that we have been <u>called</u> to suffer unjustly (1 Peter 2:21) the Holy Spirit <u>commands</u> us to <u>arm ourselves</u>.
 - → "arm" is Opl i ZW hoplizo {hop-lid'-zo} and literally means, "equip yourself with weapons".
 - → The NT likens the Christian life as a <u>battle</u> or a <u>fight</u>. (See Eph 6:10-18; 1 Tim 6:12; 2 Tim 2:3-4; 4:7; 1 Peter 2:11; 2 Cor 10:3-5)

- → A soldier MUST be thoroughly familiar with his weapons.
- → Our enemies: Satan, the World (which is under the influence of Satan 1 John 5:19, our own flesh/lusts/desires.
- → One <u>must</u> prepare himself for battle against EACH!

Weapons to Fight the Good Fight (vv. 1-6)

- ① (v. 1) The Same Purpose (mind, thought, attitude) of Christ.
 - → (John 4:34) Christ came to do the WORK "prepared beforehand that HE should walk." (Ephesians 2:10)
 - → "has ceased from sin" Christ left the "realm" of sin to go to where there is NO SIN.
 - → Death should never frighten a believer because they know that those believers that have died have "ceased from sin."
 - → The goal (purpose, passion, desire) of believers is NOT TO SIN (1 John 3:4-10; Romans 6:12-16).
 - → We know that one day we will be FREE from the PRESENCE of SIN.
 - → We must be DETERMINED to live life as the people <u>we are</u> NOT who <u>we were!!!</u> God has "blessed with every spiritual blessing. . . in Christ" (Eph 1:3) and "given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness . . ." (2 Peter 1:3-4)
- ② (v. 2) Commitment to DO the Will of God.
 - → The disciple has totally surrendered his/her life to Christ. (Romans 10:9; 2 Timothy 2:3-4)
 - → The disciple denies himself, picks up his cross daily (dies to self daily), and follows Christ. (Luke 9:23)
 - → The disciple at rebirth begins a NEW LIFE as a NEW CREATURE to live for GOD and not for himself! (John 3:3-8; 2 Cor 5:17; 5:15)
 - → Disciples know that <u>only</u> those who <u>do</u> the will of God go home to heaven. (Matthew 7:21-23; 1 John 2:15-17)
- ③ (vv. 3-5) Run a Different Race
 - → In these verses Peter is telling believers to remember their past life and how fruitless it was and how it was a waste of time.
 - → As the Christian life is likened to a battle, it is also likened to a race. (Acts 20:24; Heb 12:1-2; 2 Timothy 4:7; Philip 3:13-14)
 - → (1 Corinthians 9:24-27) The Holy Spirit tells what believers do in THE RACE.
 - ✓ Disciples RUN not walk, sit, stroll, etc.
 - ✓ Disciples RUN to WIN. They give it their ALL.
 - ✔ Disciples are temperate in ALL things.
 - ✓ Disciples RUN to obtain an imperishable crown. (2 Tim 4:8)
 - Disciples are DISCIPLINED.
 - ✓ Disciples RUN by the RULES! (2 Timothy 2:5)

- → Believers no longer run with their "old crowd"! (1 Cor 15:33; Proverbs 13:20)
- → Because they are NEW CREATURES their "lusts" or "desires" of the OLD CREATURE no longer appeal to them. Because they are no longer their "nature."
- → Unbelievers "speak evil" of believers because they are DIFFERENT. (Remember 2 Timothy 3:12)
- → Unbelievers will have to give an account to Christ and suffer His vengeance. (Hebrews 4:13; 2 Thess 1:6-9; Rev 20:11-15)
- (v. 6) The Hope of the Inheritance that Awaits Us
 - → "those who are dead" those believers that have already died.
 - → While we are here on earth we will be judged by human standards, but . . .
 - → BUT those who have died NOW "live according to God in the spirit."
 - → (1 Peter 1:3-4) GOD has begotten us to a LIVING HOPE . . . to an INHERITANCE . . . reserved for us in heaven.
- → Remember the inheritance that is awaiting us that we studied in chapter 1:4 ---
 - A City Build by God (Hebrews 11:13-16)
 - **2** A City with Many Mansions (John 14:1-3)
 - 3 A Feast/Banquet (Luke 12:37; Revelation 19:7-9)
 - 4 No More Pain, etc. (Revelation 21:3-5)
 - **6** To Sit with Christ and Reign with Him (Revelation 3:21)
 - 6 New Bodies! (1 Corinthians 15:42-44)
 - ★ EVERYONE who has this hope purifies himself just as He is pure! (1 John 3:3; 2 Corinthians 7:1)
 - **⊘** GOD! (Psalm 73:25-26)
 - → Believer groan for and eagerly await our home-coming! (Romans 8:23-25; Philippians 3:20-21; Hebrews 9:28)

What Must We Learn & DO

- We live in this world but we are NOT of this world. Our KING (Lord) has command us how to live in this world. (John 15:19; 17:14-16; Philip 3:20)
- 2 The Christian life is a BATTLE (FIGHT) and we must use the "weapons" that God (our Commander) has given us for the fight. (2 Tim 2:3-4)
- The Christian life is a RACE that needs to be RAN with the goal of WINNING the PRIZE. (2 Cor 9:24-27; Philippians 3:12-14)
- We must live the will of God. The only way to live the will of God is to be a STUDENT of God's written Word. (Matthew 7:21; 12:50)
- We must "set our minds on things above"! (Colossians 3:1-3)
