God's Eternal Purpose

- Before there was time, space, and matter GOD <u>decreed</u> (purposed, willed, planned) some to be His special people for all eternity.
 (Eph 1:4; 1 Peter 2:9; 2 Thess 2:13-14). This is the doctrine of ELECTION.
 - ★ Before time began (creation) God wrote these people's names in His Book of Life. (Revelation 17:8; Luke 10:20)
- God planned to accomplish His purpose through Christ. (Ephesians 3:8-11)
- God's plan to save His people was much more than sending Christ to die on a Cross! See handout: God's Eternal Purpose and Me
- God's plan to save His people began in eternity past and <u>continues</u> to eternity future.
- God executing His eternal purpose/plan is called "the Gospel" which He revealed starting in Genesis 1:1 and continues through until Revelation 22:21.
- Before there was time, space, and matter-there was GOD. (Genesis 1:1; Isaiah 57:15)
- Before there was time, space, and matter GOD the Father, GOD the Son, and GOD the Spirit (ONE GOD) entered into an EVERLASTING COVENANT.
 - ☆ GOD, the Father, gave His "chosen ones" (the Elect) to His Son to live and die in their place. (John 6:37-40; 10:27-29; 17:2, 6, 8-9, 11, 24)
 - ☆ GOD, the Son, agreed to be the "chosen ones" SURETY (Hebrews 7:22) and PAY the PENALTY for their sins and be their RIGHTEOUSNESS. (2 Cor 5:21; Isaiah 53:11; Jer 33:16; 1 Cor 1:30; Philip 3:9)
 - → GOD, the Father, foreordained the CROSS before time began. (1 Peter 1:19-20; Rev 13:8; Acts 2:23; 4:27-28)
 - ☆ GOD, the Holy Spirit, would be given to God's "chosen ones" as a <u>GUARANTEE</u> (Eph. 1:13-14; 4:30; 2 Cor 1:22; 5:5), to give them ETERNAL LIFE (John 3:8), and cause them to <u>DO</u> God's commandments. (Ezekiel 36:27)
 - ☆ This EVERLASTING COVENANT (Hebrews 13:20-21) was made in ETERNITY and is a <u>SURE</u> THING because in ETERNITY everything is NOW – already DONE. THIS IS GRACE. (Romans 8:28-30; Ephesians 2:4-10; 2 Timothy 1:9)

- As part of His <u>DECREE</u> (purpose, plan, will, desire) GOD <u>determined</u>
 <u>everything</u> that would happen in order that His will, plan, and purpose would
 be fulfilled. (Lam 3:37-38; Acts 15:18; 17:26; Isaiah 41:22-23; 46:9-11;
 Ephesians 1:11). THIS IS THE DOCTRINE OF PREDESTINATION. God
 does not FAIL! (2 Corinthians 1:20-22)
- NOTHING HAPPENS BY ACCIDENT or CHANCE! (Lamentations 3:37-38; Proverbs 16:33; Acts 3:6)

ALL THIS HAPPENED BEFORE GENESIS 1:1

In the Beginning GOD Created (Genesis 1:1)

- To fulfill His <u>DECREE</u> (will, purpose, plan, desure) GOD created (out of nothing) SPACE, MATTER (Isaiah 40:26; 44:24; 48:14; Psalm 102:25), and TIME (all history - Hebrews 1:2-3; 2:9-10; Colossians 1:17);
- EVERYTHING exists for His Glory! (Romans 11:33-36; Prov 16:4; Revelation 4:11) EVERYTHING!
- HISTORY (TIME, God's plan) is LINEAR. It had a BEGINNING and it has an END. It is moving toward JUDGMENT. (2 Cor 5:9-10; Romans 2:5-11; Revelation 20:11-15; Acts 17:30-31; 2 Timothy 4:1)
- CREATION is as an important part of GOD's SALVATION for His "chosen ones".
 God does everything for His glory and the good of HIS people. (Romans 8:28)

GOD Created ADAM - Our FEDERAL Head (Genesis 1-3; Romans 5)

- Adam was created in the image of GOD as our REPRESENTATIVE.
- (Genesis 3) Adam, our REPRESENTATIVE, sinned! (Acts 17:26)
 - → When Adam sinned, we sinned. (Romans 3:23)
 - → When God cursed Adam, God cursed us. (Romans 5:18)
- We are born into this world with Adam's image (Genesis 5:1-3). Our nature is that of a SINNER. (Ephesians 2:1-3) We sin because we are born sinners. We are born *in bondage* to Satan, the world and sin.
- Adam's sin was NOT a surprise to GOD. GOD <u>decreed</u> (willed, purposed, planned) that sin would enter into and be part of His creation (plan, purpose).
 (Eph 1:11; Acts 15:18; Isaiah 46:9-11)
- God promised "another ADAM" in Genesis 3:15. This "ADAM", like the first, would be the REPRESENTATIVE of His people.

ABOUT 4,000 YEARS LATER

(John 5:17)

In the Fullness of Time (Galatians 4:4)

- In accordance to HIS DECREE (plan, purpose, counsel, will) God sent His Son.
 - → His Son's life, death, resurrection, and ascension were all "written down" before time began! (Psalm 40:7-8; Hebrews 10:7-9; 1 Peter 1:20)
- Just as judgment, condemnation, eternal death, and physical death entered the world through ONE MAN's sin, justification and eternal life would come

- through the OBEDIENCE of ONE MAN JESUS CHRIST the second ADAM. (Romans 5:15-21)
- Christ came to "do His will (plan, purpose, counsel, decree)". (John 4:34; 5:30; 6:38)
- The Father's will for Christ: "... <u>all</u> that He has <u>given</u> Me (His elect) I should lose **nothing**, but should raise it up at the last day." (John 6:39)
- ★ GOD HIMSELF CAME TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE! (Matthew 1:21-23)
- THIS IS A GREAT MYSTERY WITHOUT CONTROVERSY! (1 Timothy 3:16):
 - → "mystery of godliness" MEDITATE: GOD coming in the flesh!! THIS IS THE DOCTRINE OF INCARNATION.
 - Christ was "manifested" (revealed) in the flesh! He became man! He set aside His majesty and made Himself of no reputation.

 (Philippians 2:5-9; Romans 1:3; 8:3; Heb 2:11; 4:15; 10:1-10 John 1:14; Galatians 4:4)
 - ★ Man sinned, therefore, man must die! (Rom 6:23; Ezek 18:4)
 - ★ Christ is fully man <u>and</u> fully God. It <u>must</u> be!
 - ① Only God can save. (Isaiah 45:22; 43:11)
 - ② Only God could ransom a soul. Sin requires a ransom that only God can pay! (Psalm 49:7-8)
 - ③ <u>Our</u> total depravity makes saving ourselves <u>impossible</u>, only God can do the <u>impossible</u>. (Mark 10:25-27)
 - Christ was "justified" in the Spirit. He was <u>declared righteous</u>. He was <u>without sin</u>. (2 Cor 5:21; Heb 4:15; 5:9; 7:26; 1 John 3:5; 2:1; 1 Peter 2:22; 3:18).
 - Christ was "seen" (to attend to; to see; to observe) by angels. (Luke 2:9-14; Matt 4:11; 28:2-7; Luke 22:42-43; Acts 1:1)
 - Christ is preached among the nations. (Matt 28:19-20; Acts 1:8; John 3:16; 1 John 2:2; Revelations 5:9)
 - Christ is believed on in the world. (Acts 2:41; Acts 6; Acts 10)
 - When Christ <u>finished</u> God's plan (John 4:34; 19:30; Hebrews 1:3) He ascended into heaven (Acts 1:9-10) and <u>sat down</u> at the right hand of God (Hebrews 1:3). He is there now interceding for those whom He died. (Hebrews 7:25; Romans 8:34)
- → Christ came to REDEEM His brethren given to Him by God. (Hebrews 2:14)
- → In order to redeem as the Law required (Leviticus 25:47-49) He must:
 - ① Be <u>related</u> by birth. He must be a **Kinsman-Redeemer**. Christ is our Brother! (Hebrews 2:11-12; Matt 1:21; 12:50; Rom 8:29)
 - ② Be <u>able</u> to redeem! Christ is the "Mighty God." (Isaiah 9:6; Mark 3:27; John 17:2; Matthew 28:18; Romans 9:5)
 - ③ Be <u>free</u> Himself. (2 Cor 5:21; 1 Peter 2:22; Hebrews 4:15; 1 John 3:5; 2:1; John 14:20)
 - 4 Be wealthy to pay the price. (1 Peter 1:18-19; Psalm 49:15)
 - ⑤ Be willing to redeem. Christ came to do the will of His Father. (John 4:34; John 6:37-40; John 10:17-18; Galatians 2:20; Ephesians 5:2, 25; Titus

2:14; Revelation 1:5)

- God sent His Son to herald His message of peace God's gospel of PEACE. (Romans 10:15; Ephesians 6:15). NOT AN INITIATION BUT AN ULTIMATUM. MEN ARE NOT ASKED TO BELIEVE BUT COMMANDED TO BELIEVE. (1 John 3:23)
 - ➤ God terms for peace with Him:
 - ① Continually confess and repent of your sins. (Mark 1:14-17; 1 Jn 1:8-9)
 - ② Continually believe in the gospel. (Mark 1:14-17)
 - ③ Confess with your mouth, "Jesus is LORD." (Romans 10:9-10)
 - Refusing to continually repent, believe and bow to Christ as LORD will bring God's eternal wrath. (John 3:18, 36; Luke 13:1-5)

ABOUT 33 YEARS LATER AFTER HIS INCARNATION

GOD Sacrificed His Own Son (Isaiah 53:10; Romans 8:32)

- It was God's will that His own Son would be crucified He planned (decreed, willed, purposed) it before time! (1 Peter 1:20)
- His Son came to be the SURETY (Hebrew's 7:22; Psalm 69:8; Isaiah 53:6) for His people (God's elect).
- Christ came to "give His life as a ransom <u>for many</u> (not all)." (Matthew 1:21; 20:28; John 10:18; Isaiah 53:11, 12; Hebrews 9:28)
- GOD is HOLY, HOLY, HOLY! (Isaiah 6:4; 1 Peter 1:15-16)
- Because of His holiness God must JUDGE sin, all sin, anywhere He finds it even if it is in His own Son! (Romans 8:32; Isaiah 53:10)
- Christ came to **propitiate** (appease) God's holy anger at His people. (1 John 4:10; 2:2; Romans 3:25-26)
- Because Christ fulfilled His part of the <u>everlasting covenant</u> God <u>is</u> keeping His part. (John 4:34; 19:11; Hebrews 8:10-12)
- ★ GOD DID ALL FOR US! (Rom 5:8; 8:31, 32, 34; 1 Cor 1:30; 5:7; 2 Cor 5:21; Gal 3:13; Eph 5:2; 1 Thess 5:10; Titus 2:14; Heb 6:20; 9:24; 10:20; 1 Peter 2:21; 4:1; 1 John 3:16; 4:16)
- \bigstar GOD SENT HIS SON TO SAVE HIS PEOPLE FROM THEIR <u>SINS!</u>
- ★ CHRIST CAME TO DO THE WILL (wishes, plans, counsel, desires purpose) of GOD. And HE FINISHED it.
- ★ WHAT DID HE FINISH? Through His death He satisfied God's anger toward God's special people. Through His death on the Cross God's anger was propitiated. Christ FINISHED the work! HE DID NOT COME TO MAKE SALVATION POSSIBLE HE SAVED!
