Lies Believed to Be True

- ✗ What is your definition of "the Bible"?
- ✗ What is your attitude toward the Bible?



A Call to Perseverance (Matthew 10:22)

- Throughout the New Testament God's saints are EXHORTED to persevere even under the greatest trials. (Hebrews 10:36-39; 6:11-12; 3:6, 14; James 1:12; Romans 8:23-25)
- The Christian life is a RACE and a BATTLE. (Hebrews 12:1-2; Acts 20:22-24; 1 Cor 9:24-27; Philip 3:13-15; 1 Tim 6:12; 2 Timothy 4:6-8)
- Living the Christian life is **NOT EASY!** (Matthew 7:13-14)
- Suffering, for the saint
 - ★ Produces perseverance/endurance/character. (Rom 5:3-4; James 1:2-4)
 - ★ Works for them a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory. (2 Corinthians 4:17)
 - ★ Produces groans in us! (Romans 8:18-25)
 - ★ Reminds us of our GREAT REWARD in heaven. (Matthew 5:10-12; Genesis 15:1; Psalm 73:26-27)

God Given Shepherds (1 Peter 5:1-4)

- God, and God alone, sets the qualifications for elders/pastors for His Churches. (1 Timothy 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9)
- Elders are OVERSEERS of God's sheep. (Acts 20:28; Hebrews 13:17)
- Elders are STEWARDS of the sheep God gives them. (Acts 20:28; 1 Cor 1:2; 15:9; Gal 1:13; 1 Tim 3:5, 15-16)
- Elders are ACCOUNTABLE to God. (Hebrews 13:17)
 - ★ Elders are passionate for the souls to whom they preach. (1 Cor 9:16; Jeremiah 20:9; Amos 3:8; Romans 1:14)
- Laboring elders are worthy of DOUBLE HONOR. (1 Timothy 5:17-18; 1 Thessalonians 5:12-13)
- Elders are to be OBEYED. (Hebrews 13:7, 17)



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Be Submissive (1 Peter 5:5) IMPERATIVE - COMMAND

- The Holy Spirit, God, through Peter, <u>commands</u> young people to <u>submit</u> to their elders, the leaders of the Church. This is important during a time when our culture ignores authority. We live in a time when many believe that they do not have respect, submit to, or obey their Church leaders.
- The Greek word, $\pi\rho\epsilon\sigma\beta\acute{\upsilon}\tau\epsilon\rho\sigma\varsigma$ presbuteros , is the same word for an elderly person.
 - → Respect for the elderly <u>had</u> always been taught until the 20th Century!
 - → God commanded that His people "rise before the gray headed and honor the presence of an old man". (Leviticus 19:32)
- Submission is a mark of spiritual maturity whether it be to our church leaders, in the family or in the world. Here, Peter quotes Proverbs 3:34. God promises MORE GRACE to the humble! BUT God will scorn the **arrogant**.
- Then, Peter, commands everyone to be submissive to their leaders.
- IF ONE SUBMITS TO GOD HE WILL HAVE NO PROBLEM SUBMITTING TO OTHERS. IF YOU HAVE NOT SUBMITTED TO GOD'S ELDERS YOU HAVE NOT SUBMITTED TO GOD.

Be Humble (vv. 5-6) IMPERATIVE - COMMAND

- "be clothed with" covering yourself with humility!
- Christians are to be the LOWEST of SLAVES to each other.
 - → Christ is our example. (John 13:1-15; Matthew 20:25-28; Philippians 2:4-11; Romans 12:3, 10, 16; Ephesians 3:8)
- Christ requires that we "deny ourselves" in order to be His disciple. (Luke 9:23)
- The MOST HIGH GOD dwells with only those who "have contrite and humble spirits and hearts". (Isaiah 57:15; 66:2; Luke 18:13-14; Matthew 5:3-4)
- (v. 6) Peter, really GOD, <u>commands</u> saints to humble themselves (submit themselves) under the **mighty hand** of God!
- Humility is NOT THINKING OF YOURSELF AT ALL PUTTING OTHERS' NEEDS BEFORE YOURSELF. (Philippians 2:3; Romans 12:10; Eph 4:2; 1 Peter 5:5; James 4:10)
- Suffering saints are to look to God and trust that HE will EXALT them *in due time or in His timing!*
- The HUMBLE saint -
 - ☆ (Psalm 18:27) God will save the humble, but bring down the proud.
 - ☆ (Psalm 138:6) God regards the humble, but the proud He knows from afar.
 - ☆ (Proverbs 15:33) With humility comes honor. (Proverbs 18:12; 29:23)
 - ☆ (Proverbs 11:2) Pride brings destruction; humility is wisdom. (Proverbs 16:18)
 - ☆ (Psalm 149:4) Salvation comes to the humble!
 - ★ (Matthew 23:12) Whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted.

Trust GOD (v. 7; Psalm 55:22)

- The suffering saint needs to "commit his soul to God in doing good as to a faithful Creator". (1 Peter 4:19)
- "care" is $\mu \acute{\epsilon} \rho \iota \mu \nu \alpha$ merimna meaning "anxiety" it includes reproaches, insults, slander, gossip, persecutions, troubles, difficulties, weakness, joylessness, discontentment, despair, pain, etc.".
 - ☆ See Paul's attitude in 2 Corinthians 12:9-10.
- The suffering saint needs to **trust** God! (Proverbs 3:5-7)

Be Self-Controlled (v. 8) **IMPERATIVE - COMMAND**

- "sober" is $\nu \acute{\eta} \phi \omega$ nepho {nay'-fo} and means "to be calm; collected in spirit; circumspect".
- In the New Testament it carries the idea of being disciplined in the mind; being temperate in all things; avoiding the trappings of the world. (2 Timothy 2:3-4; Hebrews 12:1-2; 1 Corinthians 9:24-27; 1 John 2:15-17; James 4:4)
- A sober-minded man is FOCUSED on his God-given goal!
- Consider the definition of "perseverance" or "patience" -
 - → "patience" or "endurance" or "perseverance" -- ὑπομονή hupomone {hoop-om-on-ay} and means "steadfastness, constancy, endurance". It is a characteristic of a child of God "who is not severed from his *deliberate* purpose and his loyalty to faith and holiness by even the greatest trials and sufferings." (See 2 Thessalonians 1:4)

Be Vigilant; Be Alert (v. 8) IMPERATIVE - COMMAND

- "vigilant" is $\gamma\rho\eta\gamma\circ\rho\acute{\epsilon}\omega$ (gregoreo) meaning "to watch; to give strict attention to; be cautious; take heed lest through remission or indolence some destructive calamity suddenly overtake one"!
- The Christian life is not only a RACE to be WON, but it is a DAILY BATTLE!
- The Christian has <u>many enemies</u> the devil and His demons, the world system, and his own flesh!
- A Christian cannot be "lazy" (Hebrews 6:11-12) or "complacent" (Zephaniah 1:12).
- Christ commanded His disciples to "Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit is willing but the flesh is weak!" (Matt 26:41)
- (Proverbs 4:23) "GUARD your heart (mind, emotions, will your whole person) above all else (with all diligence), for it is the source of your life." Satan and world targets our hearts (minds) constantly. See 1 John 2:15-17

Know Your Enemy! The Threat Is REAL!

- (Ephesians 6:11-13) Put on the WHOLE ARMOR . . . that you may be able stand
- (2 Corinthians 2:11) Lest Satan take advantage of US for we are NOT to be ignorant of his devices.
- (2 Corinthians 11:3) The serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness.

• (2 Corinthians 11:13-15) False apostles, deceitful workers, "ministers of righteousness"

Satan: The Adversary (vv. 8-9)

- · Peter describes the saints ARCH-ENEMY
- "YOUR" enemy! "devil" $\delta \iota \alpha \beta o \lambda o \zeta$ diabolos
 - → Slanderer; false accuser
- "adversary" ἀντίδικος antidikos {an-tid'-ee-kos} opponent.
- "roaring lion" predator, one who hunts to kill!
 - ★ Psalm 7:1-2; 10:9-10; 17:12; **Ezekiel 22:25.**
- "seeking whom he may devour" "to swallow up".
- (1 John 5:19) The WHOLE WORLD lies under the influence of Satan!!!
- We are commanded to RESIST him!
 - ★ "resist" is ἀνθίστημι anthistemi means to "stand firm agains";

 "to oppose" by being <u>steadfast</u> in one's faith. (1 Cor 15:58; Colossians 1:23)
 - ★ IF we RESIST, he will flee! (James 4:7)
- ALL CHRISTIANS EVERYWHERE IN THE WORLD ARE UNDER SUCH ATTACKS BUT WITH DIFFERENT TACTICS!

God's Purpose (v. 10)

- God of ALL GRACE who CALLED us to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus.
 - ★ God's glory is our reward and motivation to persevere. (2 Cor 4:17-18; Romans 8:18; Hebrews 11:25-26; John 17:22)
- "<u>after</u> you have suffered a while" our lives are but vapors eternity is forever! (See 2 Cor 4:17-18; Romans 8:18)
- GOD's GOAL: PERFECT US; ESTABLISH US; STRENGTHEN US; and SETTLE US.

Peter's Benediction (vv. 11-14)

What Must We Learn and Do

- ① We must persevere! (Matthew 24:11-13; 10:22)
- ② We must be submissive to our elders. (Hebrews 13:17)
- ③ We must be humble NOT proud. (James 4:6, 10)
- ④ We must be sober-minded. (Romans 12:1-2)
- ⑤ We must be alert. (1 Peter 5:8)
- (6) We must resist the wiles, schemes, and devices of the devil. (James 4:7)
- ② We must be STEADFAST. (1 Corinthians 15:58)
